



Wick Pre-School is a registered charity, which means that in order for us to operate, we must have a management committee in place to oversee how it is run. That committee needs to be made up of at least five committee members - 60% of which needs to be parents/carers of children that attend the setting.

At the moment, the committee is running at the minimum number required and at the end of this academic year, a number of members will be leaving. This will put the Pre-School at risk of closure.

The committee meets approximately once per term (just for a couple of hours one evening at the Pre-School) and takes an active role in helping make decisions relating to the running of the Pre-School. Acting as a voice for the parents, they help the staff ensure that Wick Pre-School continues to be the type of setting where we are confident to send our children.
