**Free Childcare Funding (15 and 30 hours) can only be used between 9 am and 3 pm. Please see chart above for costs outside of these times**

**A minimum of 2 sessions per week must be booked. Sessions can be on the same day.**

### **Funded Childcare**

#### **15 Hours**

**Free 15 hours funding – all 3 year old children will become eligible for 15 hours of free childcare the term after they become 3. You do not have to apply for this but you will be required to complete an entitlement form.**

#### **30 Hours**

**Parents of 3 and 4 year olds maybe entitled to claim 30 hours of free childcare per week. We offer parents the choice of using this term time only (38 weeks of the year) or stretching over 50 weeks. If you stretch the funding the sessions will remain the same throughout the year. Parents need decide which option prior to commencement of funding and remain with that.**

**If you are eligible, you will be given an 11 digit code that you will need to give to the office along with your National Insurance number and Child's Birth Certificate.**

### Top-Up Payments

If you use 30 hours per week, all year, top up payments will be payable. Please request a quote.

### Activity charge

- £3.50 per week for those children who attend less than 3 days

- £5.00 per week for those children that attend 3 days and more.

This is for all children at Pre-School. This helps cover costs for any of our additional clubs that we offer, including (but not limited to): multi-sports sessions, forest school, and yoga and movement to music, as well as gardening and cooking clubs.

### Snack Charge

A charge of £1.00 per day for snack which is offered in the morning and afternoon. It is usually fresh fruit and vegetables. Milk and water are available throughout the day.

### Hot Dinners

We offer freshly prepared meals onsite at a cost of £3.00 per day. Alternatively you may bring a packed lunch. Please note that we are “nut free” so do not pack anything containing nuts. Make sure that foods like grapes, cherry tomatoes, cocktail sausages are cut in half to avoid choking hazard.

### Uniform

Uniform is not compulsory. We have T-shirts and sweatshirts available to purchase.

Sometimes we have pre-loved sweatshirts at a cost of £2.50, please ask.
